HOI provides medical care from its main clinic at Rancho el Paraiso and three outlying clinics.

Since 1991, HOI has improved the health status of those it serves. About 10,000 patients are cared for during a year. The rate of immunizations in the HOI health region is 96%. 900 women per year received prenatal care. Parents of malnourished children are educated on proper nutrition and the children receive food to bring them to a better level of health.
